

Bias stitch scarf

Requires: approx 150 yards of worsted weight yarn (original knit with Bamboucle – 2 skeins on #10 needles)

#8 - 10 needles (straight or circular), stitch marker



This easy knit is a great project for a yarn with lots of “drape” or to show off a special “designer” yarn. Gauge is not an issue; the fabric should be a little loose. Knit a sample to be sure you like the way it looks.

Cast on 3 stitches.

Row 1: K1, m1, k2

Row 2: K2, YO, K2

Increase section:

Row 1: K2, YO, K to end. Repeat this row until you have 24 stitches on needles.

Biased section:

Row 1: K1, place marker, K1, YO, knit to end.

Row 2: K1, K2tog, YO, K2tog, K to end.

Repeat these two rows until piece measures 54 inches or desired length.

Decrease section:

Row 1: K1, K2tog, YO, K2tog, K to end.

Repeat this row until you have 4 stitches remaining on needles.

Bind off.
